Product design students creating an IKEA inspired chair, which is completely dismantlable, portable and easily put together on the go.

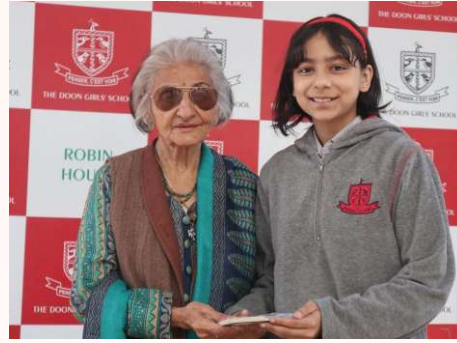
Fun creating indoors and happily putting it together outdoors to sit out in the sun!
