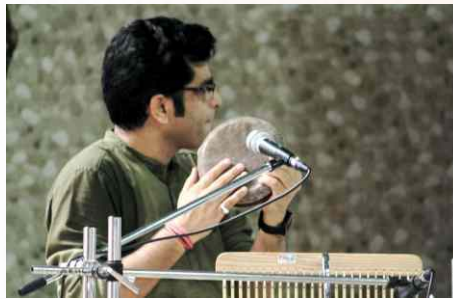




'KAHAT KABIR' PAATH PRESENTED BY SARVATRA
