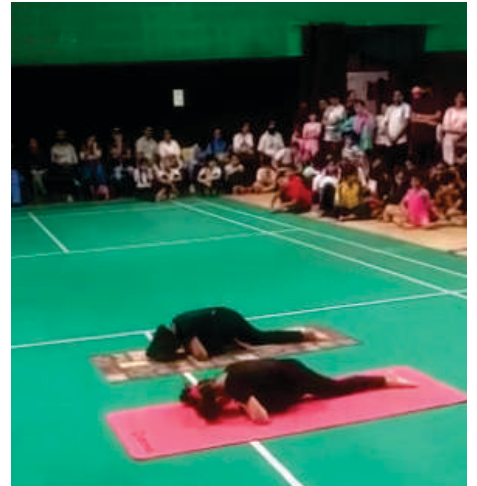


UTTARAKHAND YOGA CHAMPIONSHIP
