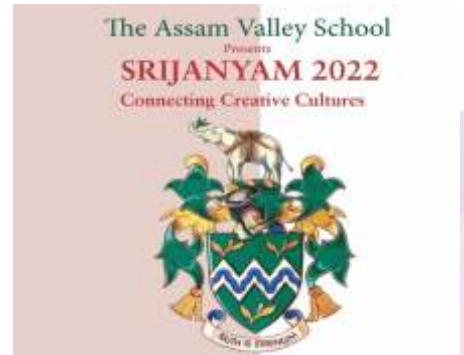


PRODUCT DESIGN AWARD Sept 26, 2022

Mountaineer Mamta Rawat who saved over 1000 lives during the flash floods of Uttarakhand told our girls to never give in to what people say; in her words "Earlier people could not understand why

I risked my life to save unknown people. Today the same people want their daughters to be like me, courageous, fearless and ready to help others even at any cost".

Dehradun based Paralympics shooter Dilraj Kaur is the first female para-rifle shooter from India. She has, in her 17-year career won 28 gold, 5 silver and 6 bronze medals, including the World Games of 2007 in Taiwan and 2015 in Bengaluru. She paved a new way not only for herself but for many more in the years to

come who would follow her path. Her story moved all of us and filled us with gratitude.

Our other guest Gullista Ansari left her job of Rs 5000 per month, took a loan and bought an e-rickshaw and became the first woman to be driving an e-rickshaw in Dehradun at the age of 26 years.

"I think some people find it difficult to accept that I'm doing what has traditionally been regarded as a man's job. But then there are those who tell me that I'm an inspiration".
